Dear Greyhound families:

This letter is to inform you that Niagara Region Public Health (NRPH) has advised us that two individuals at Garrison Road Public School have tested positive for COVID-19. For privacy reasons, the identities of the individuals cannot be shared.

NRPH has assessed the situation, and all staff and students who are required to self-isolate are receiving a notice issued by NRPH through email. If you have not received this notice issued by NRPH identifying your child's class in the letter, then your child does not need to self-isolate and can come to school tomorrow, as usual.

We want to reassure you that we are doing everything we can to make sure that Garrison Road is a safe learning environment. We will continue to work collaboratively with NRPH to ensure our school meets all the enhanced health and safety protocols. Facility Services will complete a thorough cleaning of the school and we will continue with our preventative practices, such as wearing PPE, physical distancing, hand hygiene, and daily health screening upon returning to school.
