NO RIGHT ON RED!

We were informed this week that there is a change coming to Garrison Road Public School. Please read the following information that was provided to us by the Town of Fort Erie, Infrastructure Services.

School Crossing Guards play a vital role in ensuring the safety of our community, especially during peak school hours. In response to these concerns, the Niagara Regional Council has since passed a motion to prohibit vehicles turning right from Garrison Road Public School onto Regional Road 3 (Garrison Road) when the traffic signal is red (commonly known as "No Right Turn on Red").

The Niagara Region is planning to install signage to this effect in the next few weeks.
