Help Keep Our Kids Safe



If you have ever tried to pick up your kids from the parking lot at dismissal, you already know that we don't have enough parking spots and dismissal can be chaotic. We don't want anyone to get hurt and there are ways you can help alleviate the traffic. Please consider the following options...

1. If your child is eligible, please have them ride the bus. You can pick up your child from the bus stop. Visit nsts.ca to see if your address qualifies. If you are eligible and don't currently have bussing set up, call the school and we can help.
2. For older students who are able to be dismissed without direct supervision, please use the Spears / Highpoint subdivision, located behind the school for drop off and pick up where students can walk across the back field to meet you at the gate.
3. If you must pick up out front, please stay in your car in the designated pick-up lane instead of parking. There is a teacher on duty that will dismiss younger students directly to your car when you get to the front.
