Q-MACK IS COMING TO GARRISON



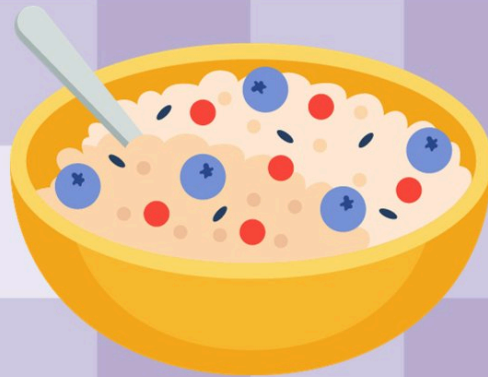
Q-Mack is bringing his “Be An All-Star” presentation to Garrison Road Public School on Friday, April 19th.
