

DSBN Google Accounts / 3rd Party Apps

Google is making changes on Monday, October 23 that may impact student account access to third-party applications (e.g. video games, retail accounts, etc.). The change does not affect access to applications approved for use in the classroom (e.g., D2L, Google Drive).

However, although it is not recommended, sometimes students create accounts for non-school-related web and mobile applications with their DSBN account (username@students.dsbn.org).



If the application has not been approved for academic use, students will see this message:

Clicking the "Request Access" link will not fix the problem, however, if students log into their personal applications before Monday, October 23rd and update their account with a personal email address (e.g., gmail, hotmail), their access and user data should not be impacted.
